Class of 1957 “Lost” List

The Lost List is a list of alumnae of whom the Associate Alumnae of Douglass College (AADC) has no confirmed home address. Possible reasons for this include: (1) The AADC has received “Return to Sender” mail without a new address; (2) The AADC only has an alumna’s business address; or (3) The alumna is deceased, unbeknownst to the AADC. As a result, there may be some alumnae on the Lost List who have email addresses as well. If an alumna wishes to be removed from the Lost List, she must contact the AADC to provide her HOME ADDRESS or inform the AADC that she is not interested in providing her contact information to the AADC.

The Grad Name below is the name by which an alumna may have gone at the time of graduation. The AADC Name is the name by which an alumna is referred to in AADC communications where it would be proper to include the alumna’s last name while attending Douglass, in addition to the alumna’s current last name.
